Lease Updates Due Now!

Due to district lines being redrawn along with 2 new schools opening in August, lease and homeowner verification will be requested from all families. Families are encouraged to check if leases are expired. Notices were



sent home recently. Please do not ignore as Greenbriar students must have updated residency information on file at all times.

Families are required to bring a copy of their current lease showing the expiration date and the page with management signature and a utility bill no later than **April 5**.

Students will not be assigned a classroom placement next year until expired leases are updated. As administration plans for the 2019-2020 school year, all residency issues must be in place.

If you are moving outside of the Greenbriar district during Spring Break, please contact the office as soon as possible so we may forward student records.
